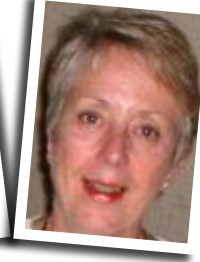

Vandalised car removed from Roundshaw Woods

At last year's local elections, a commitment was made to maintaining a clean local environment in Beddington South. Following a call from a local resident the Focus team were alerted to a burnt out vehicle that had been abandoned in the ward.

Consequently Councillor Ed Joyce visited the site to assess the problem since a number of abandoned cars had been reported at the location previously. Councillor Joyce Melican then liaised with council officers who arranged for the prompt removal of the vehicle. As part of councillors continuing efforts to maintain a welcoming environment in Beddington, reported graffiti has been cleaned including from the red hut on Roundshaw Park.



Local Cllrs Ed and Joyce took action to ensure the car was removed as part of their commitment to maintain a welcoming environment in Beddington South.

Joyce commented, "It is important to deal with these problems as quickly as possible since if they are left they become worse. Through teamwork with residents we can ensure that vandals do not blight the area."

Local Councillors support tree plan

As part of a plan to increase the number of trees planted in the borough, Sutton Council is proposing to encourage residents to adopt and water new trees planted near their homes.

Trees require a great deal of watering in their early years and this incurs a significant cost to the council. If local residents are able to water a tree close to their house this will allow for more to be planted.

"Trees can be a good way to improve the local area. However in these financially constrained times it is difficult to extend the budget. This approach could allow us to maximise the resources available" commented Joyce
