Wallington Town Centre Improvements



Your local Cllrs Bruce, Sunita and Stan are sure that residents will soon benefit from the improvements in Wallington Town centre

The Wallington Town centre improvement project, funded by Transport for London, is progressing well and expected to be completed on time by the end of June.

The new paving has been well received and the new bus shelters should be in very soon. After completion, visitors to Wallington will benefit from 30 free minutes in the Wallington Library car park designed to replace the former short stay spaces on the High Street.

Although residents have experienced an unavoidable degree of disruption, this has in part been due to the extensive improvements needed to the drainage, especially to remedy the dangerous flooding that occurs under the railway bridge whenever it rains heavily.

A Stakeholders' Group made up of Residents' Associations, local businesses, the police, friends of the library and local councillors is overseeing all of the work.
